**Whereas**, the Pleasantville School District and City of Pleasantville desire to provide the services of police officer(s) assigned to the school district on a full time basis; and

**Whereas**, both parties recognize the potential benefits of this program to the citizens of the municipality and to the students and staff of the school district; and

Whereas, it is in the best interests of the school district and the municipality to establish this program,

**It Is Therefore Agreed**, that the municipality shall supply (1) one police officer(s) to the school district during the 2015-2016 school year.

Although assigned to the school on a full-time basis, a police officer as assigned remains an employee of the municipality and its police department. The officer shall remain subject to all rules and regulations of the police department and shall not be considered an employee of the school district.

The duties to be performed at the school by an assigned officer shall be assigned through the municipal police chain of command, in cooperation with the Superintendent of Schools and/or the Superintendent's designee.

The Chief School Administrator and the Chief of Police shall maintain open communication concerning the process and effectiveness of the program.

The school shall provide the officer with a telephone and office space where students can meet and speak privately with the officer. The office must be able to be properly locked and secured.

If possible, the office should be in central location in the school building and easily accessible to students, faculty and school administrators.

The program shall be funded as follows:
