At the Regular Meeting of the Pleasantville Board of Education held on Wednesday, March 19, 2008, the Board of Education approved the following items:

Payments totaling **\$8,399,624.18** February 26, 2008 through March 19, 2008.

Whereas, the Board of Education of the City of Pleasantville in the County of Atlantic, New Jersey (the "Board of Education" when referring to the governing body, and the "School district" when referring to the legal entity) wants to build and early childhood education center (the "Project"); and

Whereas, the Educational Facilities Construction and Financing Act, N.J.S. 18A:7G-1 et seq. (the "Act") requires the State of New Jersey through the New Jersey School Development Authority (SDA) to design, construct, and finance the Project; and

Whereas, the SDA currently does not have funds to design, construct, and finance the Project; and

Whereas, the Board of Education has identified need to purchase land for the Project, which land may or may not be paid for under the ACT; and

Whereas, the Board of Education had identified land for the Project; and

Whereas, such land is bordered by Mill Road, Woodland Avenue, and New Road, and is generally identified as Block Number 157, Lot Numbers 27, 31, 35, 8, 24, 20, 33, 36, 34 and 29 on the tax map of the City Pleasantville, consisting of approximately 7 acres (the "Land"); and

Whereas, the Board of Education wants to utilize the Atlantic County Improvement Authority (ACIA) as the county agency to acquire the Land on behalf of the School District; and

Whereas, the ACIA will acquire the land by purchase or condemnation on behalf of the School District; and

Whereas, the ACIA will then enter into a long-term lease with the Board of Education, using the lease as the security to issue tax-exempt obligations; and

Whereas, the Board of Education will have unfettered use and possession of the Land under such ground lease with the ACIA; and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Board of Education of the City of Pleasantville in the County of Atlantic, New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. That the ACIA is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of the Land for the School District.

Section 2. That the Board of Education hereby agrees to the terms of the financing outlined in the attached letter from McManimon & Scotland, L.L.C, dated January 30, 2008 acting on behalf of the ACIA.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
