[Dear Mr. Thompson:

Pursuant to NJ.S.A. 18A:38-8.1 et seq., the Department of Education has verified the appropriate representation of sending district board of education members on the receiving board of education.

The Absecon School District sends 84 students to the Pleasantville School District for grades 9 through 12. This represents 9.25 percent of the 908 students attending those grades.

Based on these data, the percentage of pupils attending Pleasantville School District is less than 10 percent (the standard for representation); therefore, Absecon is not entitled to representation on the Pleasantville School District Board of Education.

A copy of 18A:38-8.2, Representation from sending school district to board of receiving district, is enclosed for your information.]

- 5. Resolution to approve the Visual and Performing Arts Departments at the high school, middle school, and elementary schools to conduct a District Band Program. The program will allow the students to showcase their instrumental music talents to their peers. This will give students an opportunity to build bonds with their peers, giving them the confidence and support they need to continue in the music program. Each group will perform approximately five (5) to ten (10) minutes. The program will be held at the Pleasantville High School on May 22, 2012, 10:00am 1:30pm. The cost to transport the elementary school students to the high school is not to exceed \$100.00 (\$25.00 each school LAS, NMSS, SMSS, WAS) utilizing account # 15-000-270-512-0000-XXX.
- 6. Resolution to approve GradeZone Points (GZpoints) an online company that rewards students with discounts to local businesses based on grades in school, attendance to school, and the community service he or she performs. The students much be 13 years and older to register to use GZpoints. Based on the average grade of a student's classes, students can earn points that can be used to redeem vouchers (coupons) to local businesses in the area. GZpoints also runs local community service events that students can sign up to earn discounts to local businesses as well. The program will also provide scholarships for students and host other types of events. There is no cost to the district for this program.
- 7. Resolution to establish partnership with The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey to engage in activities that promote student achievement, teaching and learning. These activities will include but are limited to mentoring/coaching staff and students, guest speakers, grant partnerships summer workshops, CCSS transition, and instructional practices. The contact from Stockton for the district will be Dr. Cheryl Vaughn-Jones, Assistant Dean of Natural Science and Mathematics. There is no cost to the district for this partnership.
- 8. Resolution to approve Imagine Learning as a pilot program at Decatur Avenue School, Washington Avenue School, Middle School and High School. The program is designed to enhance reading language skills for ESL students. Imagine Learning will accelerate implementation and training services to ensure they are scheduled within two weeks of signing this agreement/receiving a purchase order, a specialist will be appointed to coordinate efforts of the pilot program as well as provide up to 125 Imagine Learning Licenses to Pleasantville Public Schools to use with their students at no charge until July 31, 2012 and collect data and provide reports to Pleasantville Public Schools on students progress. We will purchase the baseline implementation and training services for each school involved in the pilot to the start of the pilot partnership. The cost for this program is not to exceed \$3,500.00 utilizing account # 11-190-100-320-0000-232.
- **9.** Resolution to establish partnership with Dr. Basilyn Bunting, Friends of American Engineering Organization, to promote and consult with district on S.T.E.M. activities that support the CCSS and curriculum. There is no cost to the district for this partnership.
- 10. Resolution to approve for adoption Envision Math Textbook series from Scott-Foresman for grades K-5. The current textbook has a copyright date of 2004. A committee of thirteen (13) teachers and administrators spent two (2) afternoons reviewing and evaluating four (4) different textbooks: Scott-Foresman, Houghton-Mifflin, Oxford-Sadlier, and McGraw Hill. Scott-Foresman's Envision Math Textbook was the committee's textbook of choice based on the ancillary and web-based materials, content related to new common core standards, organization of text and readability for students as well as teachers. Once the textbook is adopted the cost will be submitted for board approval at a later date to be ordered for the 2012-2013 school year.
- **11.** Resolution to accept the Coca-Cola Public Space Bin Grant submitted by Liza Levitt, MSP Teacher. The grant will provide the district with recycling containers to assist in the district recycling project. This grant is no cost to the district.

- 12. Resolution to REVISE the account number used for the administrator training held on March 16, 2012 during the District In-Service. The training was Board approved on March 13, 2012 item number 3. The professional development was offered by Richard Stockton State College/ Regional Institute and Educational Technology Training Center (ETTC) the topic was "Introduction to Charlotte Danielson Framework" The total cost for the trainings is not to exceed \$1,306.00 utilizing the new account #20-270-200-300-0000-545.
- 13. Resolution to **REVISE** the Pleasantville High School trip to Sister Act the Musical at the Broadway Theatre in New York, NY on May 30, 2012. The field trip was originally Board approved on April 3, 2012 and revised on April 24, 2012. This revision is needed due to the increase in the price of the tickets as there was a delay in processing of the tickets. The price was originally \$38.50 per ticket however the new price which includes box office fee is \$46.50 per ticket the difference in cost \$704.00 utilizing account # 15-190-100-800-0000-050.
- **14.** Resolution to approve the high school Guidance Counselors and Technology Lead Teacher summer work. The guidance counselors will be responsible for inputting student schedules, the technology lead teacher will align the curriculum to the new classes that will be added for the 2012-2013 school year.
