At the Regular Meeting of the Pleasantville Board of Education held on Tuesday, September 23, 2008, the Board approved the following items:

FINANCE:

It is recommended, that the payments totaling **\$5,166,070.28** September 9, 2008 through September 23, 2008 be approved by the Board. The payments have been reviewed by the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

Background:

Supplemental Educational Services via No Child Left Behind Title I Funding will be provided to eligible students in our Pleasantville School District on a first-come/first-serve basis. Our three eligible schools are Pleasantville High School, Middle School, and South Main Street School. The aforementioned New Jersey State Approved Supplemental Educational Service Providers have submitted their Contractual Service Agreements and Certificate of Liability Insurances for the 2008-2009 school year to the Pleasantville Public School District Funded Programs Office. Attached are the Contractual Service Agreements and Certificate of Liability Insurances.

The cost of these services is covered under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Title I Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Funds Account Number 20-231-100-300-0000-545. The 2008-2009 New Jersey State Approved Per Pupil Allocation (PPA) for the District of Pleasantville is **\$3,181.00**.
