Courses ran for three (3) weeks and focused on science, technology, engineering, and mathematics and a two week course focused on S.T.E.M. robotics with Dr. Bunting, who taught 30-35 students for 2 weeks not to exceed **\$ 4,800.00 Funding Source #15-000-240-300-0000-050**.

13. Be it Resolved, that the Pleasantville Board of Education approve Deneen McQueen as PHS Family Involvement Coordinator to work under the Title I program assisting with the implementation of Parental involvement activities. The graduation requirement has changed for the 2015-2015 student cohort, based upon the state assessment shift (from the HSPA to the PARCC). Under the new requirement, students can earn a diploma by demonstrating proficiency in ELA and Math on one of the following standardized assessments: SAT, ACT, or ASVAB. Based upon a memo from the New Jersey Department of Education, effective October 6, 2015, districts are responsible for putting an appeals process in place for students that have not met their assessment graduation requirement. Districts that have students who are on track to meet all graduation requirements, with the exception of their assessment requirement by the spring of 2016, can file a portfolio appeal. At the present time, at Pleasantville High School, there are 43 students out of 171 that have met their assessment graduation requirements. Because of this, 128 students qualify for Portfolio Appeals Process. In order to accomplish this task, the following resolutions are being submitted:

- Expression Mathematical Reasoning
- Modeling

ELA: Students must demonstrate Proficiency in ELA by demonstrating alternative classroom work aligned to the content categories as described below:

- Two grade level passages (one literature and one informational) and associated items that demonstrate a student’s comprehension (i.e., multiple choice items and short constructed response to open ended questions)
- Writing that includes at least two of the three types required by New Jersey Standards (informational/explanatory, argument, narrative)

- (2) **ELA:** Students must demonstrate Proficiency in ELA by demonstrating alternative classroom work aligned to the content categories as described below:
 - Two grade level passages (one literature and one informational) and associated items that demonstrate a student’s comprehension (i.e., multiple choice items and short constructed response to open ended questions)
 - Writing that includes at least two of the three types required by New Jersey Standards (informational/explanatory, argument, narrative)
