At the regular meeting of the Pleasantville Board of Education held on Tuesday, June 23, 2009, the Board of Education approved the following items:

FINANCE:

It is recommended, that the payments totaling **\$3,153,440.54** June 9, 2009 through June 23, 2009 be approved by the Board. The payments have been reviewed by the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

RESOLUTIONS/FINANCE:

It is recommended, that the Board of Education of the City of Pleasantville approve the following

Finance Action Items to be approved at the June 23, 2009 meeting:

1. Approval of 2008-2009 Purchase Orders in the amount of **\$669,142.70**.

The government provides an even match of funds for every non-cash in-kind contribution dollar generated.

8. **Resolution to accept the Reading First Grant Special allocation in the amount of \$75,000 for the period of July 1, 2009 – July 31, 2009.**

Background:

This special supplemental grant was awarded to North Main Street School because it has run a good grant program for the past five years. The funds will be combined with title I funds to run an elementary laboratory summer school. Teachers will participate in a series of pre-service training sessions on new literacy strategies with a special focus on writing. School LAL facilitators will provide in-service training each week and in-class coaching each day.

9. **Resolution to accept the FY 09 NCLB Consolidated Grant in the amount of \$2,637,255 for the period of September 1, 2008 – August 31, 2009.**

Background:

This application was reopened to include additional sub grant allocations for Title I SIA and Title I Part g. The entire NCLB Consolidated Grant was approved by the NJDOE on May, 9, 2009. Acceptance of this grant by the Board of Education is required before payments will be made to the district.

10. Resolution to approve Professional Educational Services for M&E Associates to generate NJASK, TERRA Nova and S-Test reports re-rostering spring 2009 test results into 2009-2010 home rooms and instructional groups and to conduct 7 data review meetings with School Leadership Councils and Bilingual/ESL staff in the amount of \$27,500.

Data analysis and data driven instructional practices are requirements of the NCLB annual needs assessment. These professional educational services were provided last year by M&E and unanimously recommended for this year by building principals. The cost of this service is supported under Title I.

Professional Development by LL Teach:

Rationale: This professional development experience will train teachers in the use of effective mathematics instructional practices that are based on NCTM and state standards. Teachers will learn, through demonstration, how to implement discovery-based activities for mathematics instruction. 30 teacher @ \$45.00/hr x 6 hours each = \$8,100.00.

Professional Development by Solution Tree-Lee Canter:

Rationale: The goal of this professional development is to provide training for staff members in methods of behavior management that will result in positive classroom discipline, and consistent and effective school-wide procedures and routines for managing student behavior. 30 teacher @ \$45.00/hr x 6 hours each = \$8,100.00.

10 instructional aides @ \$30.00/hr x 6 hours each = \$1,800.00.

Literacy Across the Curriculum: Professional Development by Judy Freeman:

Rationale: This professional development session will train teachers in the effective use of Read Aloud activities, book talks, creative drama, readers' theater, poetry and songs as effective ways to increase student engagement, proficiency and success in language arts/literacy. 25 teachers @ \$45.00/hr x 6 hours = \$6,750.00

Professional Development in the use of "Touch Math":

Rationale: The purpose of the Touch Math professional development is to train primary grade teachers in a skill that will provide students with a method to develop concrete and pictorial representations of numbers. This will enable students to build strong number sense concepts by using a systematic and concrete method of handling numbers and coins.

1 Trainer @ \$45.00/hr 6 hours = \$270.00. 10 teachers @ \$45.00/hr x 3 hrs each = \$1,350.00.

Professional Development by the Bureau of Education & Research:

Rationale: This professional development will train teachers in the implementation of the "Six Traits of Writing": ideas, fluency, organization, word choice voice and conventions. Implementation of the instructional strategies that increase students' use of these six traits will improve proficiency in the area of writing.

30 teachers @ 45.00/hr x 5 hours each = \$6750.00

Development of Targeted Treasure Hunt Materials:

Rationale: There is a need to develop additional Targeted Treasure Hunt materials will expand the number available for classroom use in both reading and in the other subject areas. Stipends for teachers to develop "Targeted Treasure Hunts" instructional materials for classroom use to teach narrative and expository text:
