Dear Parents/Guardians of Pleasantville High School Students:

It is with great enthusiasm that we announce the 2024 Summer Program for the Pleasantville High School. Your child will be provided the opportunity to make up failing courses, recover credit, and participate in afternoon enrichment, sports, performing arts, and S.T.E.A.M. activities. This letter is also for the parents of our Early College students who are required to attend Summer Bridge.

Our Summer program will be for students in grades 9 to 12 for the 24-25 school year. We will use the term "rising". For example, if your child will be in the ninth grade next school year, he/she is considered a "rising ninth grader".

This in-person summer program will run Mondays through Thursdays from July 08, 2024 to August 01, 2024. The summer hours are as follows:

- AM Program is Edmentum, Credit Completion, and mandatory Early College Summer Bridge (8:00 am to 12:30)
- High School STEAM (Drone piloting, Electrical Engineering, STEM) 12:30-3:00 pm (Rising 9th graders to rising 12 graders).
- Band Camp (rising 9-12 grades) @ PHS

PLEASE NOTE:

- Rising 9th graders (current 8th graders) can attend the STEAM Summer program at the HS from 12:30-3:00, but will attend the summer school program in the morning at MSP.

We will be providing breakfast, lunch, and transportation (Students will be bused from their elementary school to the High School campus and bused back to their elementary schools for dismissal).
